

Your Majesty, members of the board.

I return to continue my discussion of the lack of ethics demonstrated by the Republican members of the BOS, Mary Jones, Jim Kennedy and most especially Mr. Goodson.

Although I reiterated my ethics concerns the last time I spoke at the last BOS meeting July 8th, after 2 months of speaking, no **intervention** was forthcoming, and my concerns continued to be ignored. That alone is contrary to the COE policy that all Supervisors have signed. The policy specifically puts the responsibility of **intervention** on the BOS Chair - Mr. Goodson.

Tired of being ignored, I started an e-mail campaign to the BOS elaborating my prior 3 ethics concerns:

- 1) Appointment of Chris Henderson to PC after significant campaign contributions. This certainly is an assault on the public trust.
- 2) Mr. Henderson's lack of attention to my Public Comment at the July Planning Commission meeting. The COE specifically states attention must be given to public speakers. I requested Mr. Henderson's attention 4 separate times to no avail.
- 3) No intervention by BOS Chair when ethics concerns brought forward. As I indicated after months of alleging ethics violations, I was tired of being ignored and had to resort sternly worded e-mails.

The saga continues and ethics violations continue to mount.

My e-mails detailing the 3 prior violations were forwarded to the County Attorney for an opinion. This can hardly be considered an objective and unbiased opinion for the County Attorney only works for JCC at the discretion of the BOS. As one might expect, the opinion came to the defense of the Supervisors involved (Goodson, Kennedy, Jones) and not balanced to take into consideration the public good. Mr. Rogers our County Attorney is a public servant and should look out for the public and the citizens of JCC first and not jump to protect his boss. He did though acknowledge that the responsibility for the final decision lies with the BOS.

Afterwards, Mr. Goodson in a very arrogant and self-serving manner appointed himself Judge and Jury in his own hearing and dismissed all allegations out of hand. No **intervention** took place as dictated by the COE.

Shame on you Mr. Goodson, you are an embarrassment to the Chairmanship, to the entire BOS and to the citizens of James City County. Shame on you, nobody elected you King.

This action on Mr. Goodson's part surely belies "*the public's full confidence for integrity*" and is a violation of the JCC COE.

Pursuant to section 18 of the COE, I hereby notify you Mr. Goodson of my allegation of yet another COE violation. I await intervention that is equitable, just and ethical.
